According to the Rules & Bylaws of the Fulton County Republican Party, Inc., Article 5,
Section 5.10 Voting:

1. Proxies may be given only to another member of the respective committee (Note: Please ensure that you obtain permission from the person you are giving your proxy. No committee member may vote more than three (3) proxies at the same meeting.)
2. Any proxy may be revoked in writing or by attendance of the committee member in person at the meeting for which the proxy was given.
3. As to both the Executive Committee and the Operating Committee, any committee member who is absent from two (2) meetings within a calendar year without submitting a valid written proxy in advance of each such meeting, shall be deemed to have resigned from the same at the conclusion of the second such meeting of said committee.
